Lessons Learned:



BUY-IN

- Needed at different levels
- Lack of buy-in caused by a variety of issues
- PRE can help build buy-in by demonstrating impact



DEPARTMENTAL SUPPORT

- Support is needed from different departments, often including IT
- PRE can demonstrate these needs in reports to gain support across departments



STUDENT INVOLVEMENT

- Students' level of involvement plays a role in impact
- PRE can collect data around student awareness
- Assess data for subgroups of interest



INSTITUTIONALIZATION

- PRE can show the need for institutionalization by demonstrating impact
- PRE helps get these conversations started by asking questions about the institutionalization early in the grant
